



Monument and Bench Requirements

Effective March 15, 2023: the Acceptive of Size, Design, Materials and Intended Location as Authorized by the Cemetery's Rules and Regulations Include:

FOR MONUMENTS/MEMORIALIZATION THAT ARE NOT PURCHASED FROM THE CEMETERY:

Prior to being installed at Corona Cemetery, written approval is **required** by the cemetery. A scan/fax/mail or personal delivery is acceptable. A design drawing/order form indicating the type and thickness of **solid granite** to be used and the measurements is required prior to the cemetery approving the authorization for setting. The vendor/family is responsible for assembly and delivery including off-loading to the memorial storage area prior to setting these memorials. Upright monuments and benches may only be set in areas approved within the cemetery for this type of memorialization.

The Endowment Care deposit and setting fees must be paid and contract must be signed by the recorded property owner prior to the cemetery accepting delivery.

Monuments: Including their required base and foundation must not exceed 36 inches in width. Overall height must not exceed 48 inches including the base, foundation and die without approval from the Board of Directors.

Foundations: All monuments must be set on a concrete foundation that is three inches (3in.) thick and two inches (2in.) wider and longer than the base of the monument. The concrete foundation is to be supplied by the vendor prior to or at delivery time. **The vendor provides the foundation. The cemetery does not. Benches: size, design and materials** require

approval in writing by the Board of Directors prior to placement in an area designated by the cemetery.

Flat Markers

Prior to being installed at Corona Cemetery, written approval is **required** by the cemetery. A scan/fax/mail or personal delivery is acceptable. The vendor/family is responsible for off-loading to the memorial storage area prior to setting the marker.

The Endowment Care deposit and setting fees must be paid and contract must be signed by the recorded property owner prior to the cemetery accepting delivery.

Sizes:

36 x 12 x 3 (2 side by side graves)

28 x 16 x 3

24 x 12 x 3

20 x 10 x 3 (cremation garden / infant garden)

*2-inch concrete border allowed

Setting Fee/Endowment Care

Any size upright - \$1,250

Benches: \$1,250

Slants: \$700

Flat Marker (28x16 or 24x12): \$350

Infant/cremation marker (20x10): \$130
